• **Environmental Committee**

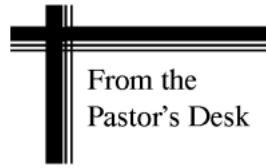

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In fact, Christ has been raised from the dead (1Cor 15:20). To our contemporary ears, these words of St. Paul sound basic, obvious, even commonplace. But in this passage from St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians we have the world's oldest written account of the Resurrection. So it was that, for the people of Corinth, these words were not basic or obvious but new, exciting, and life-changing. They were words of hope.



This year our world in general and the Diocese of Ogdensburg in particular need hope. During the Year of St. Paul we have faced many challenges—many crosses. We have experienced sickness, death, and depression. The challenges of the fiscal crisis have affected both international agencies and family dinner tables. And none of us is able to say that we are unaffected by experiences of sin. In short, we have known the Cross. So we turn to our faith—faith that *whenever I am weak, then I am strong* (2Cor 12:10); faith that the cross is not the end; faith that through Christ we are offered new life.

This Easter we discover what the Corinthians learned so many years ago: that *in fact, Christ has been raised from the dead*. And with confidence in this truth we are given the hope of eternal life. May the eternal newness of the Gospel and the hope that comes from the cross, death, and resurrection of our Lord fill you and all those you love with joy and peace this Easter.
